

England 2026 Travel Program Cost & Preparation Guide

Get ready to explore, learn, and grow through an unforgettable travel experience. Below is your cost breakdown and key prep info to help you pack with confidence and excitement.

Program Fee: \$5,500

This fee covers:

- Round-trip airfare
- All breakfasts and several group dinners
- In-country travel
- Scheduled entrances listed in the itinerary
- Medical travel insurance (this is not the same as travel cancellation insurance; travelers seeking cancellation ins. must pursue it on their own)

Note: This fee is tentative until airline tickets are purchased. The program fee will be paid in two installments.

Single Supplement: \$1,040

If rooming arrangements result in a single room by default (due to odd male/female breakdown), this supplement may apply.

Course Credit Option

Want to earn academic credit while you travel? Students who opt to take the course for credit will earn CE/SLE credit. Fees for credits will be handled directly by the Business Office and will cost approximately \$900. This is a special half-price study abroad discount!

What's Not Covered

To help you budget wisely, here's what you'll need to plan for separately:

- Lunches & most dinners
- Souvenirs
- International phone service
- ETA visa: \$12 (completed with passport before departure)
- Free day entrances & travel

Travel Readiness Checklist

Adventure calls! Make sure you're ready for:

- Being 18+ years old at time of travel
- Walking up to 8 miles/day
- Able to manage winding bus rides and crowded public transport
- Extended periods of standing and ability to manage your own suitcase on stairs
- Able to travel with 1 suitcase and 1 backpack (carryon will not be a second suitcase)
